

What's the deal with the Nephilim?

GENESIS 6:1–4

When human beings began to increase in number on the earth and daughters were born to them, 2 the sons of God saw that the daughters of humans were beautiful, and they married any of them they chose. 3 Then the Lord said, "My Spirit will not contend with humans forever, for they are mortal; their days will be a hundred and twenty years." 4 The Nephilim were on the earth in those days—and also afterward—when the sons of God went to the daughters of humans and had children by them. They were the heroes of old, men of renown.

NUMBERS 13:33 33 We saw the Nephilim there (the descendants of Anak come from the Nephilim). We seemed like grasshoppers in our own eyes, and we looked the same to them."

Anakites literally means long-necked (tall) men.

According to Joshua 15:13–14 and 21:11, Anak was the son of Arba, for whom the city Kiriath Arba (aka Hebron) was named.

In Joshua 11:21, based on that location—Hebron—and the name Anak, we see that the Anakim (or Anakites) were Anak's descendants.

Deuteronomy 9:2 tells us that the Anakites were very tall and strong.

Joshua 11:22 tells us that Joshua drove them out from the **Promised Land of Israel's inheritance, and a remnant of** them found refuge in Gaza, Gath, and Ashdod.

2 SAMUEL 21:20-21 20 In still another battle, which took place at Gath, there was a huge man with six fingers on each hand and six toes on each foot-twenty-four in all. He also was descended from Rapha. 21 When he taunted Israel, Jonathan son of Shimeah, David's brother, killed him.
