## Week 12: WRITE IT ON THEIR HEARTS

## **DEUTERONOMY 11:26—29**

26 See, I am setting before you today a blessing and a curse—27 the blessing if you obey the commands of the Lord your God that I am giving you today; 28 the curse if you disobey the commands of the Lord your God and turn from the way that I command you today by following other gods, which you have not known. 29 When the Lord your God has brought you into the land you are entering to possess, you are to proclaim on Mount Gerizim the blessings, and on Mount Ebal the curses.

## DEUTERONOMY 6:6—7

6 These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. 7 Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.

## PSALM 78:1-4

1 My people, hear my teaching; listen to the words of my mouth. 2 I will open my mouth with a parable; I will utter hidden things, things from of old— 3 things we have heard and known, things our ancestors have told us. 4 We will not hide them from their descendants; we will tell the next generation the praiseworthy deeds of the Lord, his power, and the wonders he has done.

## DISCIPLESHIP IS ABOUT TESTIFYING AND TEACHING:

- Testimonies that bring glory to God
- Teaching that encourages obedience to God

## MATTHEW 28:18-20

18 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

## JUDGES 2:10

10 After that whole generation had been gathered to their ancestors, another generation grew up who knew neither the Lord nor what he had done for Israel.

## DEUTERONOMY 6:6—7

6 These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. 7 Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.

Teaching is life on life conversation—making your everyday dialogue center on testimony and Scripture about Jesus.

"Teach them diligently."


Teaching in a sharp and penetrating way


## We need to be honest about who we were and the pain that it caused.

People are not going to stumble into faith by accident and they're not going to get it by osmosis. We have to tell them.


### WHO?
